	Users may also use an eReader, like a Nook or Kobo.
	Users may access materials using one of the following apps: iBooks, Stanza, B&N Nook, Kobo, Bluefire or GoogleBooks.
	Calibre is an open source option for converting one eBook format to another. You may use Calibre to convert your EPUB into a format that is compatible with your eReader.
	Finally, materials can be downloaded as a PDF and read on your device.
